The Banking Codes and Standards Board of India (BCSBI) is a collaborative venture set up by the Reserve Bank of India and the member banks to evolve Codes and Standards for banks to follow while dealing with customers to ensure fair treatment of customers. BCSBI also acts as a watchdog to ensure that the Codes and Standards adopted by member banks are adhered to in true spirit.

BCSBI is looking for Senior Vice Presidents on contract basis, at its Mumbai Office, for carrying out studies of practices adopted by member banks and monitoring the implementation of the Codes adopted by banks.

Job Profile: Candidates are expected to have sound knowledge of Banking Laws and Practice and Regulatory instructions with particular reference to customer service. They should be able to work without support in a computerized environment and be familiar with MS-Word, Excel, Power Point, etc. Excellent communication skills with regard to drafting of thematic reports, press articles and Code Compliance Rating reports coupled with clear understanding about customer service in banks, are a pre-requisite for the job. In addition to this, experience in Administration and Accounts may be considered as an added advantage but not a limiting factor. Candidates fulfilling the following eligibility criteria may apply for these positions as prescribed below:

Work Experience	Should have held the position of General Manager/ Deputy General Manager or equivalent rank in a bank in India or Reserve Bank of India for a minimum of three years.
Age	Not exceeding 62 years as on November 1, 2016.
Emoluments	Consolidated amount per month as per organisation terms. No other monetary or non-monetary benefit including accommodation or transport would be provided.
